BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

1. Specific outcomes to be achieved from the educational process for students in kindergarten through grade twelve shall be recommended for approval by the School Board by the Superintendent.
2. The expected outcomes will include basic knowledge and the ability to read, spell, speak, write effectively, and think critically and creatively.
3. At all levels, provisions shall be made for a wide range of individual differences in student abilities and learning rates through uses of a variety of materials, adjustments in programs, and courses adapted to special needs of students.
4. The curriculum shall meet or exceed those requirements established by the Code of Virginia, the State Department of Education, and the State Board of Education. The curriculum will be aligned to the Standards of Learning.
